Storage and Handling: Sphingosine-biotin is relatively stable at room temperature as a solid. It is best stored as a lyophilized solid at -20°C. Solutions/emulsions of sphingosines should be kept at -20°C. Storage in basic buffers (pH > 9.0) or acidic buffers (pH < 4.0) may cause decomposition.

Background: Sphingosine is formed through ceramidase catalyzed hydrolysis of ceramide. It is a potent inhibitor of protein kinase C ($IC_{50} = 1-3 \mu M$). Sphingosine is phosphorylated by sphingosine kinase to the bioactive lipid sphingosine 1-phosphate. This sphingosine analog is labeled with biotin at the -position and can be bound to streptavidin coated surfaces such as beads, microtiter plates, etc.
